- Minimum GPA 3.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Desire to pursue major and career in mathematics or other sciences
- Actively involved in community service and extra-curricular activities

- Completed academic scholarship application including essay
- Official high school transcript/college transcript
- Copy of application for admission or letter of acceptance from college or university.
- Two (2) sealed letters of recommendation (other than relatives)
  - One letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or college professor
  - One letter of recommendation from individual verifying your active involvement in community service. Reference must be in leadership role within service organization.
